



What does TALOS center at the University of Crete do? What does it specialize in?

Talos is the only Center for advancing research and education on Artificial Intelligence for Social Sciences and Humanities (AI4SSH) in Crete, and one among very few in Greece.

- It provides courses on AI4SSH and develops relevant educational materials (e.g. MOOCs, ppts, etc).
- It promotes research on a) Semantic Annotation of Ancient Texts, b) Classifying and naming objects of cultural heritage, c) Quantitative Analysis of Corpora, d) digitalization of education and Ontologies of curricula, e) HAI-NLP Software for SSH, f) Standards for SSH.
- It organizes seminars, workshops and trainings for post-graduate students and open events for the general public.
